A voluntary cost-share program to help landowners restore habitat on their land Project Emphasis	On the ground voluntary habitat restoration for migratory birds, anadromous fish, and listed and declining species.
Eligible Landowners	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • private parties • corporations • non-profit organizations • tribes • cities • counties • schools
Cost-Share	Applicant must match Federal share. (The match can be in the form in-kind goods and services.)
Funding Amounts	From less than \$1,000 to \$25,000. Most awards are \$5,000 to \$18,000. We also provide technical assistance on project development.
Total Available	About \$800,000 total for California and Nevada.
Duration	Minimum agreement: 10 years. Maximum agreement: 30 years
When to Apply	Projects are developed year round. Funding decisions will generally be made by March.
