

Join us for a unique opportunity to improve nesting habitat for the Western Snowy Plover at Sweetwater Unit of the San Diego National Wildlife Refuge Complex in Chula Vista. We'll be enhancing this important nesting habitat by removing invasive ice plant and spreading oyster shells to create suitable nesting grounds for the plovers. Volunteers should work in old clothes (ice plant stains!), long pants and boots or sturdy shoes and wear sunscreen, sunglasses, and hats. We will provide work gloves, tools, snacks and water (bring your own reusable water bottle if you have one, otherwise cups will be provided). Please note that only heavy rain cancels this event. You don't need any special skills to volunteer - only a willingness to learn, work hard, and get your hands dirty!
