**CALIFORNIA WATERFIX – WITHDRAWAL OF BIOLOGICAL ASSESSMENT,
WITHDRAWAL OF ENDANGERED SPECIES ACT SECTION 7 CONSULTATION,
AND REQUEST TO WITHDRAW BIOLOGICAL OPINION**

Dear Director Souza:

Today, the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) withdrew its approval of the California WaterFix project (WaterFix). This letter is to notify the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) that the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) and DWR withdraw the WaterFix Biological Assessment dated July 2016 and submitted to USFWS on July 29, 2016, as amended, and their request for formal consultation on WaterFix pursuant to Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act, submitted to USFWS by letter dated July 29, 2016. In addition, because WaterFix is no longer being pursued by DWR, Reclamation and DWR jointly request USFWS to withdraw its biological opinion for WaterFix that it issued on June 23, 2017.

Reclamation and DWR thank USFWS and its staff for their time and energy devoted to the Bay Delta Conservation Plan and WaterFix.
