I looked at a FAA data layer from ScienceBase as well and did not see anything denoting wind turbine designation. So I pulled the Geodatabase the FWS pulls every month. Attached is a shapefile for all the Wind Turbines from that Geodatabase.

After going through that data and comparing it to the USGS wind turbine data and various imagery sources I ended up with 4 additional Wind Turbines from the FAA that were actual wind farm type turbines and that I could confirm as built. I also attached this as a separate shapefile (FAA_Additiona_WindTurbine.shp). These 4 are well out side the GRSB Current Range and at the very SE edge of MZ 7.
