Hi all-

Per our conversation and follow up discussion with management here and with the sage-grouse biologists, I think I have a better understanding and hopefully can be more clear in my expectations.

FOR GIS ANALYSIS:

1. Please continue to work on the footprints for the various chapters where we will be doing GIS overlays (e.g. current oil/gas, current ag conversion, infrastructure, mining).
2. Continue to use current range for mapping and for initial analysis (acres impacted).
3. As we get the abundance and distribution models completed, we will also ask for your assistance in intersecting with those layers. This will give us a three-legged stool (current occupied range, abundance, distribution).
