GIS Team,

As discussed on the Wednesday team call, the BLM delivered a hard drive with a large number of raw ADPP and no-action alternative files they received from the BLM EIS teams. These files were not processed into usable rangewide data sets. BLM has said that they could finish the delivery with merged files by March 31st.

So that I am not the only one able to access these files, and so that we are not reliant on the BLM hard drive, I have put them on ScienceBase in their raw form with no metadata. This way they are available should we determine that, in order to meet specific deadlines, we will need to process the files ourselves. Please note that **at this time no decision has been made regarding if we, or the BLM, should process the files.**
