Subject: WAFWA EOC agenda recommendations

Good afternoon. We'd like to take this opportunity to offer a few suggestions for the agenda at the upcoming WAFWA EOC meeting in Omaha in March. We appreciate the on-going conservation efforts of our State, Federal and other partners and we believe the EOC meeting is a great opportunity to highlight those decisions and accomplishments. We have discussed the list below with the three regions of the FWS and share this on behalf of the agency. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact us.

BLM: Presentation on Plans and Decisions. As the BLM/FS plan revisions and amendments are coming to closure and discussions are had at the state level regarding plans, a comprehensive presentation and discussion at the EOC would be beneficial in understanding the planning decisions and overall BLM/FS strategy.

States: Presentation on Plans, Implementation, and other new developments. Several states have finalized or are drafting Executive Orders and it would be helpful to have a comprehensive State by State update of plans, implementation and new regulatory or executive developments.

WAFWA: Presentation on Fire and Invasive Species. There is a lot happening on fire and invasive species issues and we recommend that the agenda devote some time to the new products and status of on-going efforts related to fire and invasive species.

USFWS: The FWS offers to provide an update of the Conservation Efforts Database as well as the status of various efforts to engage private lands conservation across the range through implementation of Candidate Conservation Agreements with Assurances.

USGS: If applicable, we recommend a presentation from USGS and others regarding upcoming science publications.
