Hi, I'm not sure where he got 16% but here are the facts that were given at our last SGIT meeting.

First the statements in the emails refer to core areas as not being in compliance. We did not report on Core Area compliance. We reported on permitted activities. We do not know at this time (other than Douglas Core Area) the total existing disturbance by core area.

Since 2012 we had 234 compliant DDCTs and 105 non-compliant DDCTs. The noncompliant DDCTs were all a result of existing disturbance that exceeded 5% and projects that all had valid existing rights. Due to better planning, citing etc, the 105 non-compliant (with valid rights) DDCTs added only 26 disturbance acres - total -and many of the proponents agreed to offset the disturbance with reclamation projects on existing disturbance.

If you look at our CED submittal, you will find that even when we had non-compliant projects, there was a net gain in conservation by either the proponent or other entity.

99% of the deminimus projects were compliant.

12 out of 31 core areas had no projects.

I suspect that if you add the number of DDCT and Deminimus projects the compliance ratio is 84%. but I wasn't able to chase that down at the moment.
