**Subject:** Federal LUP Decision Layers - UPDATE  
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Hey Gang!

Just wanted to provide you with an update I recently received from the BLM. Not sure if it's breaking news, but we might want to discuss how it affects several of our status review processes.

Originally I was told the BLM State Offices would be giving their LUP Decision Layers (I believe there's about 21 of them) to the NOC for QA/QC on February 20 and to be delivered to us the last week in March (31).

However, that timeline has been updated and the NOC will now have LUP decision layers available to us on **February 20**. At that point in time if we'd like the 'No Action' layers we can have them, we just need to let them know.

The NOC will then be working on their Cumulative Effects Analysis (CEA) during March and in April will begin calculating the stats for their Landscape Report (describing the change/delta from 2010/'No Action' to present (ADPP - proxy for RODs)) by the end of April. That doesn't allow us much time before the May meetings, and I've asked that if the Landscape Report stats are calculated by MZ that we could get them as they're finished, and will check back in soon to see if that's feasible. We may want to discuss if we want to attempt to run those stats internally, but we would be duplicating effort, with teh rub being not much time before the May meeting(s).

That's 8 acronyms, a little uncertainty, and this may generate a phone or conference call -- so I believe I've checked all the boxes and satisfied all the requirements, and render this email complete.
