These are identified in italics with bright blue shading. If there is no blue shading no resolution was needed.

I do need a few folks to take a quick look at some parts as detailed below. Of course you are all welcome to review all of the document I provided comments in and provide feedback! 😊

UT - please check out the "resolution of mapping issues" in our table to ensure I captured our concerns correctly.

Jesse/Dawn - please review the fire and invasives section, and the mitigation section.

Jesse - please review my response in the the monitoring section

Mary/NV - please provide any current information you may have for NV in locatable mineral development.

One key issue identified in the BLM document but not our table is that NV will not include a disturbance cap. This is a concern for us, and I understand it is ripe for resolution at

WAFWA this week.
