Hi Craig -

I did a cursory view and didn't have major concerns. However, I anticipate the first question from the FOs will be how is this different than the stoplight matrices they completed for their state and federal plans? This worksheet asks for slightly different information, and additional information on local/county efforts. I think that needs to be acknowledged in any transmittal e-mail for three reasons: 1. stop the backlash (but not grumbling) before it starts (especially given all the work that is going to the FOs right now); 2. provide absolute clarity to the ask and format and 3) to make sure the information is the most current..

that being said perhaps we should cross-walk this with the stoplight matrices (if you haven't already - it was a very cursory review) and figure out if we are asking questions that have already been answered.

I'm going to spend a little more time with this and if I have any specific comments I'll share.
