Thanks for asking for input. I'll respond to the survey, but I also wanted to offer these thoughts:

First, I think Jesse suggested making time to discuss our evaluation of BLM's implementation of their conservation plans, especially in the Great Basin – is that right? Mary has offered some good ideas on this, and we're working on a way to structure that discussion now.

Second, The Fire & Invasives Assessment Team (FIAT) process is in full swing and is essential to sage grouse conservation in the Great Basin. So we suggest spending time checking in on that process. Again, we're working on structuring that conversation now, too.

Third, Steve Abele, Genevieve Skora, and the rest of us here in Reno talked at length yesterday about approaches to ensure we're focusing our analyses on the most essential questions that may affect the Service's decision later this year. One thing we've learned is Ren usually asks us to say what's changed since our last decision – i.e., the 2010 finding. That's primarily the approach we took in the bi-state process. Steve and Gen are going to try to schedule a time for us to talk to you and Pat this week to discuss this idea, in case you and others think it might be a useful approach.
