<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Review Unexploded Ordinance information</li> <li>✓ Have Illinois hunting license and habitat stamp</li> <li>✓ Have Williamson County deer tag</li> <li>✓ Have signed Self-Check-in Hunting Permit</li> <li>✓ Have signed 2023 Crab Orchard Hunting regulations</li> <li>✓ Have a <b>Crab Orchard NWR Entrance Pass</b> or <b>Duck stamp</b> or <b>America the Beautiful Pass</b></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ No vehicles behind refuge gates</li> <li>✓ Bicycle use permitted</li> <li>✓ Weapons on bicycles must be in case or made inoperable</li> <li>✓ No hunting within 50 yards of buildings, roads, and areas posted closed to hunting (see map)</li> <li>✓ Possession &amp; or use of alcoholic beverages are prohibited</li> <li>✓ Deer stands with identification may be left up to 24 hours. Stands must be removed at the end of your hunt.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Complete Crab Orchard game harvest slip and put it in the drop box at headquarters or hunter check-in</li> <li>✓ Report your harvest to IDNR at 1-866-452-4325 or online at <a href="http://www.exploremoreil.com">www.exploremoreil.com</a> by 10 PM day of harvest</li> </ul>

**Hunter check-in:** Hunters must check in once per season before they start their hunt and return harvest report at end of their season on last day of
