## Information on Attending the Virtual Public Meeting

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service has scheduled a virtual public meeting on May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023, from 6-8:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time (EST). The virtual public meeting is intended to give the public an opportunity to learn more about the red wolf program.

The Service will hold the virtual public meeting via the Zoom online platform so that participants can attend remotely. During the virtual public meeting, attendees can join by computer or phone to learn about program updates. The virtual public meeting will start with a brief presentation by Service staff followed by an opportunity for attendees to ask questions on the program.

We recommend that members of the public log into the Zoom meeting platform 5 minutes prior to the beginning of the presentation to ensure that they can connect. If using the phone-only option, participants will be able to listen to the virtual public meeting, but they will not be able to view the presentation.

# For Participants Joining by Zoom Web Platform or Zoom App:

3. On the day of the meeting, please join using the information contained in your confirmation email.

#### For Participants Joining by Phone:

I. Register for the meeting (see above). On the day of your meeting, call in using one of the toll-free phone numbers listed below. You will be prompted to enter your Webinar ID. Enter your Webinar ID from your confirmation email and press the # key.

2. You will then be prompted: "Enter your Participant ID followed by #. Otherwise just press #." Phone-only participants will not receive an individualized Participant ID, so just press the # key.

3. You will be directly joined to the meeting. If the meeting has not started, you will be on hold until the meeting begins.
