January Restricted Area Deer: Archery

Illinois State Hunting Regulations Apply to Crab Orchard National Wildlife Refuge

Hunt Dates: January 7th - January 14th

Before your hunt:

- ✓ Review Unexploded Ordinance information
- Have Illinois hunting license and habitat
 stamp
- ✓ Have state Archery deer tag
- ✓ Have signed Self-Check-in Hunting Permit
- Have signed 2023/24 Crab Orchard Hunting regulations
- Have a Crab Orchard NWR Entrance Pass or
 Duck stamp or America the Beautiful Pass

During your hunt:

- No vehicles behind refuge gates
- ✓ Bicycle use permitted
- Weapons on bicycles must be in case or made inoperable
- No hunting within 50 yards of buildings, roads, and areas posted closed to hunting (see map)
- Possession & or use of alcoholic beverages are prohibited
- Deer stands with identification may be left up to 24 hours. Stands must be removed at the end of your hunt.

After your hunt:

- Complete Crab Orchard game harvest slip and put it in the drop box at headquarters or hunter check-in
- Report your harvest to IDNR at 1-866-452-4325 or online at www.exploremoreil.com by 10 PM day of harvest

Hunter check-in: Hunters must check in once per season before they start their hunt and return harvest report at end of their season on last day of hunting.
