Good morning,

Yes, this is consistent with the discussions during the tour. The ranch was going to take the hard copy maps of the boundary, annotate types of boundary fence and existing crossings, and digitize them to share with the Tribe and others. I'll talk with Ben and Andrew to see if they can get a status update for us.

The ranch manager was going to start implementing some of the crossings at identified areas. They were also going to work with the Tribe to potentially install some game cameras at crossings to see how animals use them.

As for Andrew's sketch, they were going to try it at some locations. Not sure how it will work, but has some potential for areas where moose calves are frequently seen.
