Intern will:

- Co-design stewardship activities
- Identify barriers that limit access to volunteer engagement and retention, then implement solutions
- Participate in refuge visitor services projects

Duration: 12-month internship; starting October 7, 2024

Pay: \$600 weekly living allowance (paid bi-weekly)

Benefits: \$1,100 to/from travel allowance (paid once), \$1,000 duty related travel reimbursement, health insurance, housing available on site

Note: Eligible for AmeriCorps Education Award of \$6,895 and Public Lands Corps (PLC) hiring authority
