Matt,

We can work with "a minimum of 1 acre". I note that the difference between 0.999 acres and 1.000 acres is 43.56 sq ft, a rather small amount.

Regarding the lead paint issue, we need to delete " put forth a good faith effort to". This certification is required, and a good faith effort is not strong enough.

It is understood that STPH, Inc. itself will not be undertaking lead and asbestos abatement, but that it will put forth a good faith effort to obtain said certification documentation from the restoration partner.

Hi Bill,

Rochelle and I just got off the phone and edited the prior draft AIE, which you will find attached. Most edits were just semantics and already agreed to in our meeting this week, but what I have highlighted are the substantive edits that I'm seeking your feedback on. Rochelle correctly pointed out that STPH will not be the ones who do the lead/asbestos abatement -- that falls to the restoration partner. So, the edited language reflects that distinction.

Secondly, Rochelle wondered if we could delete the "more or less" after 1 acre. Is there a way to ensure the appraisal/subdivision does not come in at anything less than 1 acre? So, 1.001 acres good, 0.999 acres bad.....
