There is no comment period currently open. The US Fish and Wildlife Service is completing a Compatibility Determination for year-round access (associated with commercial aquaculture activities) within the use easement tidelands of Dungeness National Wildlife Refuge. This assessment is necessary because year-round use does not fall within the October 1 - May 14 access closure identified as necessary to maintain compatibility with Refuge Purposes in the Refuge's 2012 Comprehensive Conservation Plan and associated Compatibility Determinations.

Compatibility Determinations associated with a Service action, have at minimum a 15-day public comment period. Contact information for those comments would be provided to the public with notice of the compatibility decision.
