Anita,

Attached are my completed data forms for the Sequim-Dungeness sites. The only new site is a location where my swan counters (Audrey and Bob Gift) found a few groups of swans. I have attached a map of the location. I named the site Woodcock-Taylor Ranch. Apparently they saw two different groups from Woodcock Road. One group west of junction with Taylor Ranch Rd and one group east of Taylor Ranch Rd. I will let you decide if there is any chance you want to combine the site with "Coon Pond" site which is along Taylor Ranch Rd. I'm leaning towards having as a separate site. We have not seen swans there before and who knows if they will use the location again.

I have a few other important notes to convey to you.

- 1) Brown Road Site – I discussed the situation with Tim. He had not added the Brown Road to his data forms but did list what he saw there in his e-mail. I have Brown Road on my forms so I simply put Tim as the counter and provided his numbers for what he observed. At some point.....I will get you a map that shows a revision of the Brown Road site. It will basically include the grassy area by the church where Tim saw the wigeon and geese. This is ¼ - ½ mile south of where I saw the birds last year.
- 2) Swan Numbers – I have reviewed all swan numbers except for any swans Sue may have seen at the Game Farm Site. The swan volunteers counted a total of 194 swans for the day. I looked at the times and locations of all their observations. To have all swan numbers balance out I recommend the following: 1) Keep all swan numbers on saltwater that Bob B. reported. 2) Add a total of 24 swans to Tim's count at the Smith Farm Fields. Total = 159 (not 135). (This is easiest correction considering that the swan counters also counted there and counted 159). 3) When we get Sue's data we need to see what she observed at the Game Farm site. The swan counters observed 8 swans in this vicinity off Lamar Road. We will need to confirm what (if any) swans Sue may have seen there. Sue's form should have her count or for sure at least 8 swans seen by the swan crew. I hope that is clear.
- 3) Dungeness Recreation Area and Lotzgesell Sites – You and/or Sue have covered these sites in the past. I'm not sure if Sue may have counted these sites this year. When we talked before the Dungeness survey day she said she was planning to survey her usual survey areas but we did not really go through the list. I did want to convey that I did survey all these sites on Jan. 5, 2017 on my travels west to survey sites near PA. There was no open water at the county park and all ponds all Lotzgesell Rd. and Ken's pond were all frozen solid. No ducks were seen. If Sue did not cover and report data.....you could add these two sites to my Page 2 form.

- 4) Marine Drive – Sue and I have not had a chance to discuss our cooperative efforts along Marine Drive and the Spit. I have included concentrations of ducks I saw at the west, south, and east side of Graveyard Spit in my count from Marine Drive. I have made the assumption that she was likely unable to see these birds.

I have cc'd Sue on this message but will likely not hear back from her until early next week. As I mentioned in an earlier message....I'm willing to work with you Sat or Sun to get final products for submission before you leave on Monday. Just let me know what you need. I can plan to work on writing up summary tables next week. I really did not take many notes this year. Basically noted if frozen or not and recorded the count numbers in my small field notebook. Please let me know if you have any questions about any of the information I have provided today.

I cancelled my plan to go to a potluck tonight and feel good about getting you all my forms (as promised).

I hope you and the dogs have a wonderful trip to OR. Happy Truffle Hunting!!

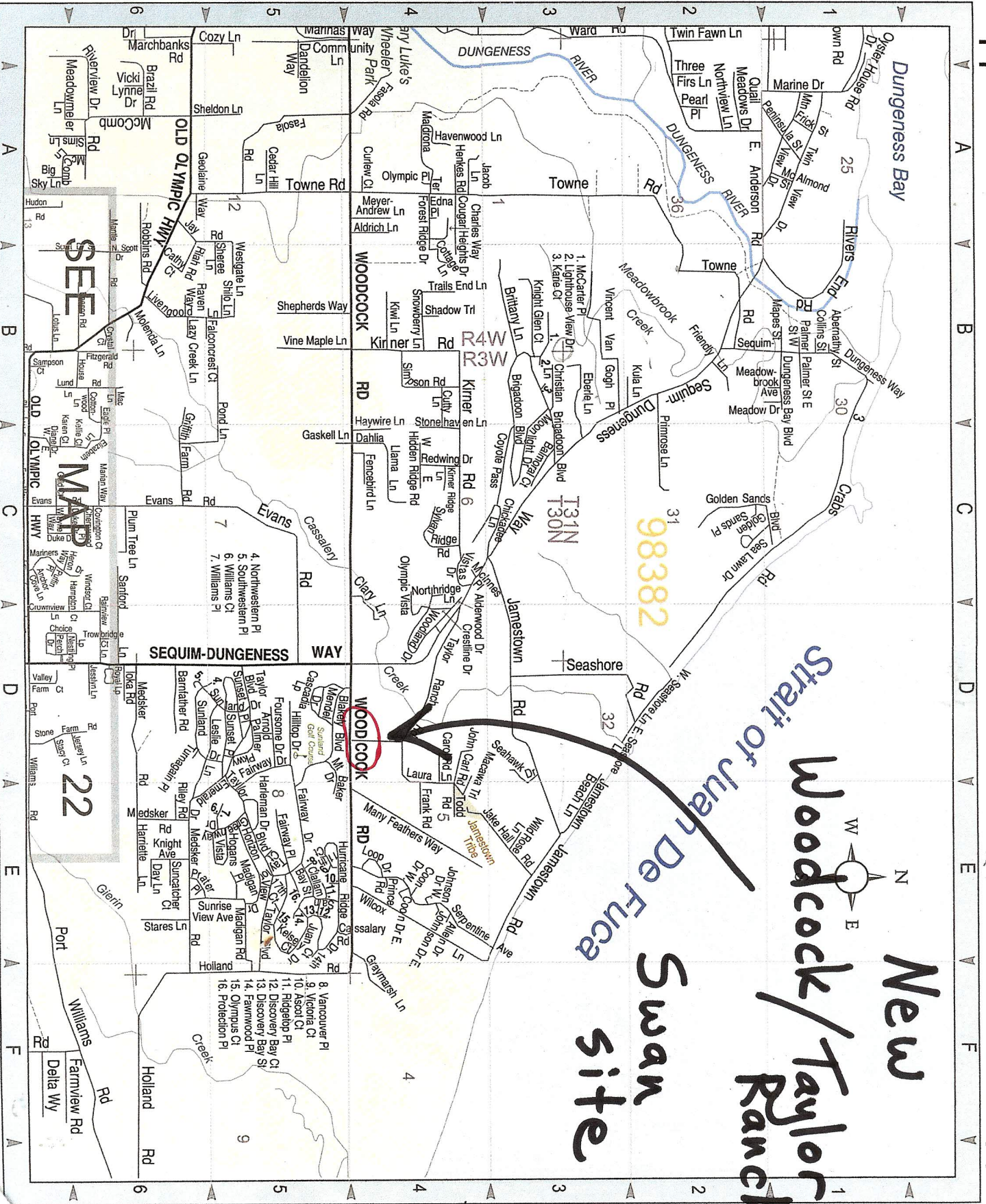

Notes for Anita

- 1) I conducted Dungeness surveys on January 4, 2016. It was a full survey day so I did not have any opportunity to search for new areas that day. On January 6, 2016, I was surveying known sites east of Sequim and had some time to do some searching in the Sequim area.
- 2) Weather conditions and visibility were fairly good for all surveys on both days. There had been freezing temperatures during the night for several days before January 4th. There was frost on the ground in the morning and a very light dusting of snow. There was a very light rain for the first few hours of the survey but then there was clearing with sun breaks for the remainder of the day. Temperatures ranged from 31degrees early to 38 degrees later in the day. It was cloudy on Jan. 6th with a few sun breaks in the afternoon.
- 3) Nearly all inland ponds in the Dungeness area were completely frozen. No ducks were seen at any of the sites where ponds were completely frozen. These ponds were not frozen when seen from an aerial survey on December 28, 2015 and ducks had been present. There were a few ponds that were partially frozen with some small openings of open water. Ducks and geese were observed at these sites.
- 4) I documented no new sites for January 4th but did locate a group of cackler geese at a new site (Priority 3) along Brown Road on January 6th.
- 5) I spent time walking into pond areas at inland sites in the morning on Jan. 4th. Many survey sites I can access from my backyard. I also had several pairs of mallards directly on my property in Meadowbrook Creek.

- 6) All ponds at the Bell Farm and Quacker Farm were frozen. These areas are included in the designated "Willits" site. I hiked in to all pond areas. Decoys were present at most ponds and were froze in the ice. No ducks were observed at ponds or in the farm fields. The Seashore Lane site is adjacent to the east of these farms.
- 7) The Marine Drive area and Three Crabs site present some challenges for counting the high number of birds present and for identifying birds that were far away. We may want to have extra observers at these sites in the future when waterfowl numbers are high. Some groups of birds were also moving around (flush/re-landing during the survey) so it was difficult to have an accurate count. I did the best I could. If not pressed for time....I would have stayed longer at both these sites.
- 8) I did coordinate my survey along Marine Drive for the time period that Sue and Lorenz were counting along the Dungeness Spit. We consulted a few days later to confirm what areas we could survey from our respective locations. We both felt confident that we were not double counting birds.
- 9) You can review my field notes to get more specific details about the survey. I did not include any time information on my survey form but this is recorded in my notes.
- 10) I did include the Wilson Field and Fairbanks counts in with the Friendly Lane tally (as we discussed in 2014). No ducks counted ...so easy.
- 11) As usual - I did include the count from Gary and Elaine's pond (2 doors down to north) with the Meadowbrook Creek count.
- 12) I did not find any obvious corrections needed on Don's list for the sites I surveyed in Dungeness.
- 13) It was interesting to note the dramatic change in waterfowl numbers along the saltwater with the variation in tides. Counts can be so different at one site within a fairly short range of time. Mallards and wigeon certainly group up along shorelines at lower tide.
- 14) I was not aware of any active hunting during our survey day (or even a few days prior). Most hunters I spoke with reported they had seen very few ducks on their property since the freeze periods after Christmas.
- 15) I did take various photos during the day of Dungeness surveys that have been downloaded to a file on my computer.
- 16) Volunteers counted swans the same day as our Dungeness survey. Swan data from all observers will need to be reviewed and provided as accurate as possible.

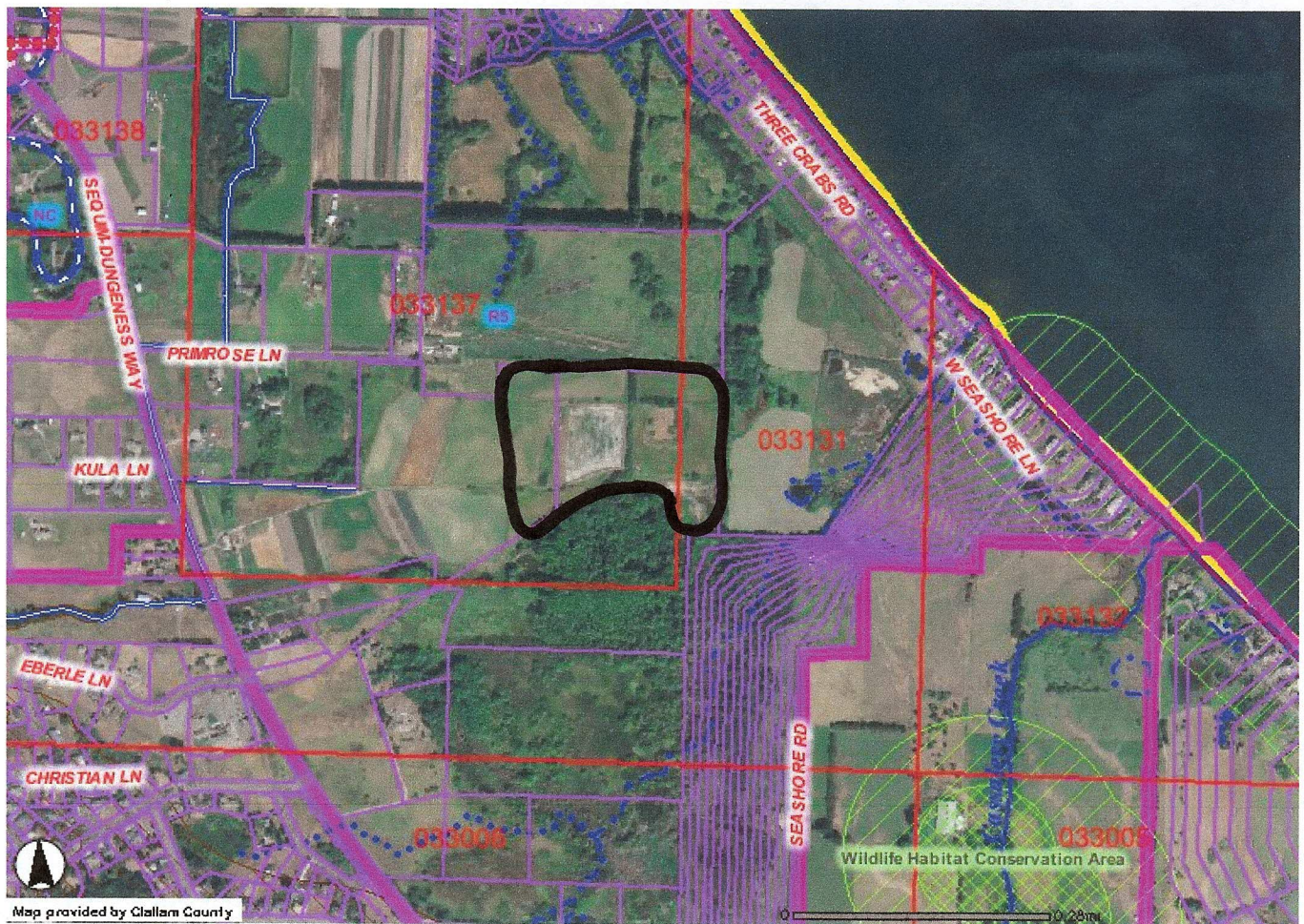

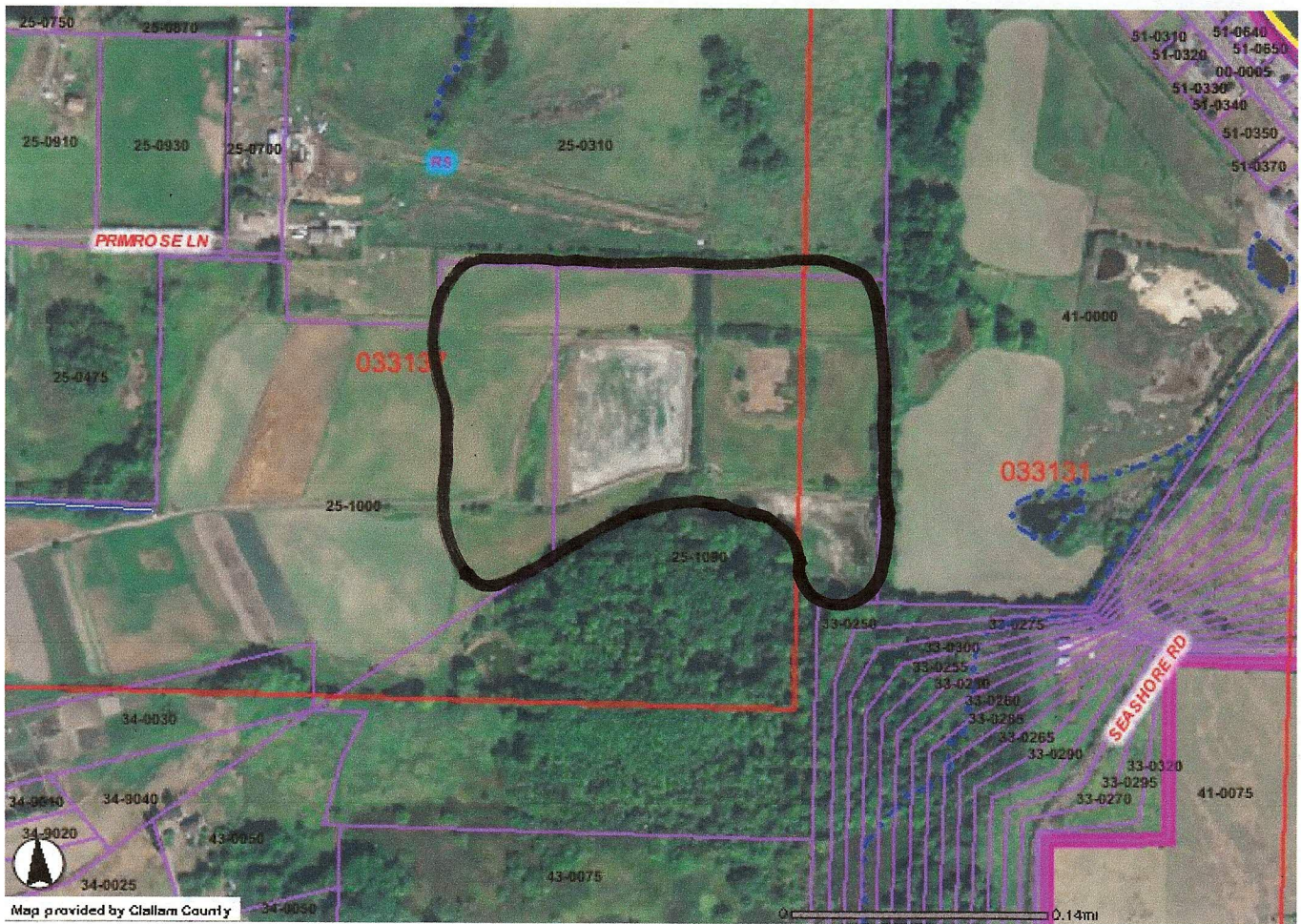
