Hi Guys,

Hope all is well with you. We got the following request from the Jamestown S'Klallam tribe who are working on a permit for doing a commercial aquaculture operation within the boundary of the refuge. We want to give them the best available data and how to provide it for their use in their permit process with the Army Corp of Engineers. Jennifer wanted me to contact the RO (I'm starting with you) because of her concern... "I would talk to the survey folks about the accuracy of the boundary shapefile first. It appears to be shifted. Whatever we provide should be sent with a description of the data's limitations.

The tribe sent this:

I'm working with Liz Tobin to provide maps to the Army Corps of Engineers for the permit the Jamestown Tribe is applying for on Dungeness Bay. The only coverage I have of the refuge is from Clallam County and it isn't complete or accurate. Do you have a shapefile or a geodatabase of the refuge boundary that you can email to me? Let me know if you have any questions. Thanks.

Any help is appreciated. As usual we are not given much lead time.
