I think there is recognition that we need to examine all possibilities before we consider throwing a red card on the project, particularly since the compatibility determination on commercial operations is going to be a surprise to the Tribe. That said, I repeatedly asked if they saw a path to a positive determination, and the responses were "we don't know enough about the project" rather than "we are committed to working closely with Tribe and believe we can find a way." It may take some further encouragement to get to "yes".
