This may have been forwarded from Brett Hunter in the Atlanta region so I apologize if this is a duplicate.

The FWS FOIA office has migrated to an intake/review process. Under this new process, the Intake Team is responsible for perfecting requests and gathering all responsive records. Once the records are received the request will be assigned to a Review Coordinator within the FOIA Office who will

work with the SME on the release of the records. John DeClerk will still serve as your Coordinator and will most likely be your Review Coordinator.
