Hello. I have the draft of the EIS for the 10j rule. The analysis of wolf depredations on livestock could be more meaningful if the data was used to show the number of ranches that would be depredated, average losses and more accurate dollars spent by ranchers to prevent losses. I will use NASS data, some WS reports and want to review the state reports and other reports the FWS used to post on their website. Can you send those reports to me? Also, can I use you as a reviewer of what I write. It likely will be 3-4 pages. You can look at the EIS and see Table 4-3 and the associated paragraphs. I told Nicole Ault and Lauren Toivenen that I would re-write the section and submitted as part of agency comments. Thanks and good to see you last week.
