We held our regulations review meeting yesterday and developed some specific questions that we'd like to discuss at our next call. I understand that our call tomorrow has been cancelled. I will be out of the office on the 24th, the date of our next call - perhaps there is a way to find a time to meet between now and then (I'm out next week on Spring Break)?

Here is what we'd like to discuss... (Reid/Brian/Dave, feel free to add or clarify if need be).

Notification requirements for lethal take currently state 'within 24 hours'. There are situations where this take may occur in remote locations. We will use language '...within 24 hours, unless impractical.' Is FWS ok with that modification?

FWS requires written take authorization for intentional harassment, which includes less-than-lethal munitions. This has the potential to become a heavy workload to issue take authorization for everyone that wants to have ability to use beanbags, rubber buckshot, etc. What are some potential solutions to keep these tools deployable while also minimizing the burden of offering written take authorizations? Can intentional harassment be deployed without written take authorization?

Bison are not included as livestock in our regulations. Can this be adjusted within the 10j to reflect and match the status in CPW regulations?

Would FWS consider removing the ability to remove wolves from interactions with pets? CPW recommendations to our commission is to not allow that. Inclusion in the 10j creates some challenging situations.

We will include language in our comment letter to FWS, but also wanted to have these conversations directly with you all.
