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Hi, all.

When Exec Sec received the CO wolf 10(j) final rule OMB briefing paper, they said, "we'll try to work with OIRA to get a determination." Then they asked:

Is there a projected date for when this rule would get to OES? I did not see it on the 90-day List.

[note from Anissa: he's referring to the July to September 90-day list, which projects rulemaking actions that will be delivered to Exec Sec and ready for OMB review during the timeframe from July 1, to September 30, 2023. The final rule for this action was not included by ES on that list.] If OIRA determines the rule is significant we'd need it in OES and at OIRA by August to publish by November."

Can you please provide an answer to Exec Sec's question? I 'm assuming the answer is something like: we expect/hope for a "not significant" determination from OMB, and are planning a delivery date to Exec Sec for review and clearance in October, but we need to confirm that OMB determination now because our publication timeline is inflexible. If OMB designates the final rule as "significant," then we would hustle to get the rule to Exec Sec in late summer or early fall.

Hi PRB, attached is our significance determination request BP for the CO wolf 10(j) final rule.
