



Circumstance	Management Tool
Non-injurious, nonlethal conflict minimization practices by livestock owners or their agents	Opportunistic <u><b>hazing</b></u> of any gray wolf in a non-injurious manner is <u><b>permitted at any time</b></u> .
Potentially injurious non-lethal hazing techniques by a livestock owner or their agent	Opportunistic <u><b>hazing</b></u> of any gray wolf in a potentially injurious non-lethal manner is <u><b>permitted at any time</b></u> .
Take in self defense	Any person may <u><b>take a gray wolf in defense of the individuals life</b></u> or life of another person
Agency take of wolves determined to be a threat to human life and safety	State or Federal <u><b>agent</b></u> may promptly <u><b>remove any wolf that is determined to be a threat to human life</b></u> or safety
Taking of wolves in the act of attacking or chasing livestock	<u><b>After issuance of a permit</b></u> , any <u><b>landowner may immediately take a gray wolf in the act of attacking livestock</b></u> on their private land or land that they are legally grazing.
