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Missisquoi NWR Seeks Public Comment on Draft Compatibility Determination

Missisquoi National Wildlife Refuge is seeking public review and comment on a Draft Compatibility Determination for Environmental Education and Interpretation. This is a renewal of an existing Compatibility Determination for these uses. No changes are proposed. The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (Service) will accept comments received or postmarked on or before November 4, 2024.

The Service prepares Compatibility Determinations to ensure that public and economic uses of national wildlife refuges do not interfere with or detract from the purposes for which each refuge was established. Compatibility Determinations also describe how these uses would contribute towards achieving refuge purposes and the mission of the National Wildlife Refuge System.

All comments received from individuals become part of the official public record. The Service's practice is to make comments, including names and home addresses of respondents, available for public review during regular business hours. If you wish to have your name and/or address withheld, you must state this prominently at the beginning of your comments.
