For the Farallon project, 1/25/19 is still our target date for the NOA of the Final EIS. It cannot be moved later if we are to submit the Consistency Determination to the Coastal Commission (90 days in advance of the ROD) and make the ROD target date. Perhaps it could be moved up slightly, but as we discussed when we developed this timeline, the holiday season will make that difficult. I felt when we put this timeline together, we already felt strapped for time. So I'm hoping that we do not need to make adjustments at this time unless they want to give us more time to get the ROD done.

I attached a revised timeline based on our slightly adjusted review period for the Admin Draft EIS. Let me know if you have any other thoughts on this. Thanks.

Good Morning,

Got an email from Gina Shultz this morning asking us to review the target dates that we set for EISs that are underway. It appears that the Department wants to see how they can spread out the clearance briefings. In order to come up with the briefing schedule they've asked us to review the dates in the attachment and confirm their accuracy and revise if necessary. They also want to know if the date is flexible (the date they are referring to is in blue text). If the date is flexible we need to tell them whether the date can be moved earlier, later, or both.

Each of these EISs is still held to the April 26, 2019 completion date unless a waiver is issued, so keep that in mind before telling them that we can move the date out.
