Ok, we'll work with you on that. My thought on the power analysis is that we should shoot to get something done as soon as we can so we can make adjustments to study design if needed. I know something for upcoming season is too short, but our goal should be to have analyses done in time to make adjustments for 2016-17 rainy season if need be.

I'll change due dates to the following. This will be in the SOW of the agreement mod:

Power analysis: Draft report due March 31, 2016. 30 day review period. Final report due June 15, 2016.

Spatial analysis: Draft report due June 30, 2016. 45 day review period. Final report due

September 30, 2016.

Kaylene and I will want to meet you before you begin analyses so we can go discuss and mutually agree on details of the analyses and final product.

Hi Gerry

Jaime and I are a bit concerned about these proposed dates. None of this work is part of our work plans for this fiscal year (ending March 2016), as funding was totally uncertain and even the possibility of this was abstract when we put together budgets and work plans. We were hoping that as this would start at the beginning of your fiscal year, reports could come at the end of your upcoming fiscal year (i.e. September). The power analysis is simpler and could have draft reports maybe by the end of our FY (end of March 2016) if really needed, but the spatial one will definitely take longer (i.e. September). Keeping to the timelines you propose would really mess with Ryan's schedule. I hope this is ok, let us know.
