Hi Anne,

The Region 8 Inventory and Monitoring (I&M) Program is supporting the project titled "Invasive Plant Monitoring Protocol and Field Survey" in FY 2017- 2018. The project was selected for funding under the FY 2017 Region 8 NWRS Invasive Species Grant Program. Regional 'Invasive Base' funds and the I&M program both contributed funding to cover the total funding request of \$49,145.00. I&M is contributing **\$26,845** from FY 2017 (178) funds to the monitoring protocol and field surveys portion of project. The I&M program was unable to transfer the FY2017 funds (\$26,845) last year but the funds will now be transferred. The FY 2017 funds will be allocated to your refuge through an office fund transfer over the next two weeks. The remaining balance of funding for the Farallon Islands NWR project (\$22,550, for invasive plant control), as well as the FY 2017 Marin Islands NWR project (30K, inventory), were provided by the regional office in FY 2017 as part of base invasive funds to the Complex.

We are very glad that we can support this work and see the project completed.
