Hi Brad (and Gregg),

Sorry it's been so long since I've been in touch.

As you know, we have acquired some funds to resume the NEPA process. We'll be assembling a revised team (some old, some new) very soon to go back over where we left off and strategize the path forward. As part of that process, we'll be reviewing the revised reports you sent and certain other documents that were produced or were being drafted.

In the email you sent on 5/21/15, you said you'd be sending a CD with the references, but I don't recall receiving that and can't find it here in my records. Did you recall ever sending it. Even so, can you re-send it? I would accept something on Google Drive or another shared site if that's easier.

We just awarded a contract to Environmental Policy Solutions, Gabrielle Feldman's firm, for NEPA support. Gabrielle's NEPA expertise and knowledge of the DEIS will help move us along efficiently. I'll be working with Gabrielle to go back through the Admin Record files you submitted to make sure we have everything we need. I'll be in touch if we find any documents we need but don't have so we can find the most efficient way to obtain them from you.

I hope all is well with you all there at IC. Sounds like you guys are keeping busy.

Apologies for the delay. Richard has just been able to complete incorporating comments into the attached reports.

For the Hazing Trial Report, Richard reached out to Pete and Russ and they have plans to address any comments as part of getting that submitted as a published manuscript. I believe that is the preference – to have a published MS – so don't think it makes sense to address those comments on the report now. If you disagree let me know. I think those changes would fall on Russ and Pete anyways as they had the most familiarity with the trial.
