1. Dan and I gave another public presentation on the need for mouse eradication on the Farallones and the credentials of IC, and where the process stands last Thursday to the Marin Audubon. It was well received and all in attendance were supportive. Still the similar questions about reducing impacts to non-targets came up and the need for short answers to the 'counter points'.
2. Attached is the interested individuals outreach shell. In doing it I found that there is overlap between this one and the other three shells I completed. I also felt I was starting to re-type the other original list into the format so I used some shorthand and referenced past lists. Basically I think we need to start moving forward with re-evaluating the questions and having short answers to the counter points. That is indicated in the outreach materials needed.
