I just talked with Madeline, here is the status of their freight:

- The 55 ga. drums at HAF; these are empty and will not be filled until sometime tomorrow morning.
- Per Madeline; water and mouse bait are in Santa Cruz; ETA to be delivered to HAF is 0800 tomorrow. She cannot get anything to HAF earlier than 8 AM.

Summary:

There is not any freight currently at HAF which needs to go to the island.

Recommendation:

- ✓ See if Madeline can get the materials to HAF earlier tomorrow.

Our first trip out (due to daylight constraints) is estimated to be at 0645 – 0700. If they could be there at 0630 it would be good.

- ✓ Play it by ear; if we can take any of this out to the island without disrupting the overall plan, we will.
