A coordinated entrance into the nesting habitat would be best. It would have been a waste of time setting up that fencing to protect the birds yesterday if they just get disturbed enough by people today to abandon their nests anyway!

- At 8:05am SpaceX provided notification of a small wildfire south of pad believed to be on TPWD property. Believed the fire has self-extinguished. SpaceX will confirm and provide coordinates of fire.
