Frequently Asked Questions

The guidance indicates that applications are to be made via the <u>GrantSolutions</u> platform. Currently, our organization does not have an account on this platform but instead uses <u>Grants.gov</u> to apply for any US Federal Government grants/funding.

Q. Are you accepting applications using Grants.gov?

A. Yes, applications may be submitted either through <u>Grants.gov</u> or through GrantSolutions. Q. The *Application Checklist* on p. 30 refers to "Items 1-10" of the *Project Narrative*. What are those ten items?

- A. Those ten items, as found in the *Project Narrative* section beginning on p. 11 are:
 - 1. Project Title
 - 2. Statement of Need
 - 3. Project Goals, Objectives, Activities, and Methods
 - 4. Project Timetable
 - 5. Relevant Party Engagement
 - 6. Support for Protected Areas
 - 7. Project Monitoring and Evaluation

- 8. Description of Entities Undertaking the Project9. Sustainability10. Map of Project Area
- Q. Should Literature Cited also be included?
- A. Yes, Literature Cited should be included as an addendum.
- Q. Should the required 1-page CVs for key personnel and the Government/Impacted Party Letters of Endorsement be included as appendices?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Are other appendices allowable, for example an organizational chart, list of participating subject matter experts, etc.?
