What additional steps might the Service consider in the future? Additional measures the Service might take that would benefit grizzly bear recovery include increasing and refining monitoring methods, *relocating bears to the North Cascades* ecosystem, and conducting additional genetic research.

I think the idea of augmenting (not relocating) the existing bears in the North Cascades is excellent but it should not replace augmenting the existing bears to the Cabinet-Yaak. It should instead read:

What additional steps might the Service consider in the future? Additional measures the Service might take that would benefit grizzly bear recovery include increasing and refining monitoring methods, *augmenting ~~relocating~~ the existing bears in the Cabinet-Yaak and North Cascades* ecosystems, and conducting additional genetic research.
