FYI, we have received our first Notice of Intent to Sue on the Bitterroot reintroduction. It's from the Mountain States Legal Foundation and others, and states that they intend to sue Babbitt, Clark and Glickman for violating the ESA if the plan to introduce grizzlies in the Bitterroot is not immediately withdrawn. They state that it would mean releasing bears within their current range, that it would negatively impact other listed species (gray wolves and lynx), would cause irreparable harm to property owners and livestock operators etc. I faxed a copy to Susan Linner, Jill Parker and Johnna Roy.
