Jamie and Ralph have talked and here is the resulting revised timeline:

Tuesday, October 10

- Ralph calls the IGBC members and signs the ROD
- Final Rule is signed
- Late Tuesday or early Wednesday, Jamie calls Governors and US Senators

Wednesday, October 11

- Media call and in-State briefings for Congressional and Governor staffs, outreach materials go up on the web
- DTE receives via overnight mail (marked for morning arrival) the signed ROD (3 signature pages w/ original signatures)
- Rule and ROD delivered to Federal Register before 2:00 pm

Thursday, October 12

- Rule and ROD go on file at FR

Friday, October 13

- Rule and ROD published in the FR

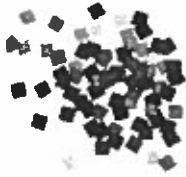
