Ben,

Per our communications this morning, in cooperation with Wildlife Services, 2 adult male grizzly bears were captured on the Henry's Lake Flats in an area with chronic cattle depredations. Both bears were caught following a confirmed grizzly-cattle depredation. Bear #1 was captured, collared, and relocated in mid-August following his capture for a confirmed cattle depredation. Bear #2 is the target bear for capture on the property that has had numerous confirmed cattle depredations and walking wounded cattle over the past 6 weeks.

We recommend lethally removing both bears.
