Interested applicants can find general information about the available grazing units below. The estimated stocking rate is provided to help applicants decide if the unit may fit within their operational capacity. The stocking rate may vary annually based on weather conditions or changing management needs. In general, management seeks to achieve moderate utilization of forage within a rotational grazing system. A specific plan (timing, duration and rotation) will be finalized with the cooperator when the grazing permit is issued. The existence and condition of fence may vary by unit. Applicants are encouraged to contact the Refuge Manager with any questions prior to applying.
