Subject: Amendments to CITES Appendix III

Background: On October 9, 2025, the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) Secretariat posted a Notification to the Parties (No. 2025/117) announcing amendments to CITES Appendix III species listings, which will be effective on January 7, 2026.

<u>Action</u>: Beginning January 7, 2026, all shipments into and out of the United States containing the species listed below (including parts and products) must be accompanied by the appropriate CITES document (i.e., CITES export permit, CITES certificate of origin, or CITES re-export certificate). Shipments must also be inspected and cleared by the Service's Office of Law Enforcement at a designated port or a port authorized under a Designated Port Exception Permit.
