Notice of Cooperative Agriculture Opportunity


U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Seeks Agricultural Producers for Cooperative Agriculture Program

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service is seeking proposals from agricultural producers to enter into a Cooperative Agriculture Agreement at the Nestucca Bay National Wildlife Refuge in Cloverdale, Oregon. The producer may have use of approximately 84 acres of lowland pastures on the Bay Unit of the Refuge for up to five years as a cooperator with the Service. The selected cooperator(s) will be required to manage the lowland pastures by grazing, mowing, haying, and/or green chopping annually between April 15 to October 31.

To apply, please complete and submit FWS Form 3-1383-C (Commercial Activities Special Use Permit Application) and the FWS Form 3-1384 Bid Sheet. Forms and more information regarding this opportunity can be downloaded at www.fws.gov/refuge/nestucca_bay. **The deadline for submittal is 4:00 pm on March 16, 2026.**

Successful applicants will be selected through an open and competitive process. Applications will be scored and ranked using objective criteria described in the detailed notice on the refuge website. All applicants will be notified by 4:00 pm on April 3, 2026.
