Compatibility Determination for dredge material spoil removal from Onslow Island

The Savannah National Wildlife Refuge (Refuge) is evaluating the removal of up to 100,000 cubic yards of spoil material from the Onslow Island Dredge Material Containment Area (DMCA). The placement of spoil material from the Savannah River onto the Refuge and subsequent removal for commercial purposes is directed by a perpetual use agreement by the United States Army Corp of Engineers (USACE) and the United States Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS). The Refuge has completed a Draft Compatibility Determination (CD) that evaluates this use and has posted it for public review and comment.
