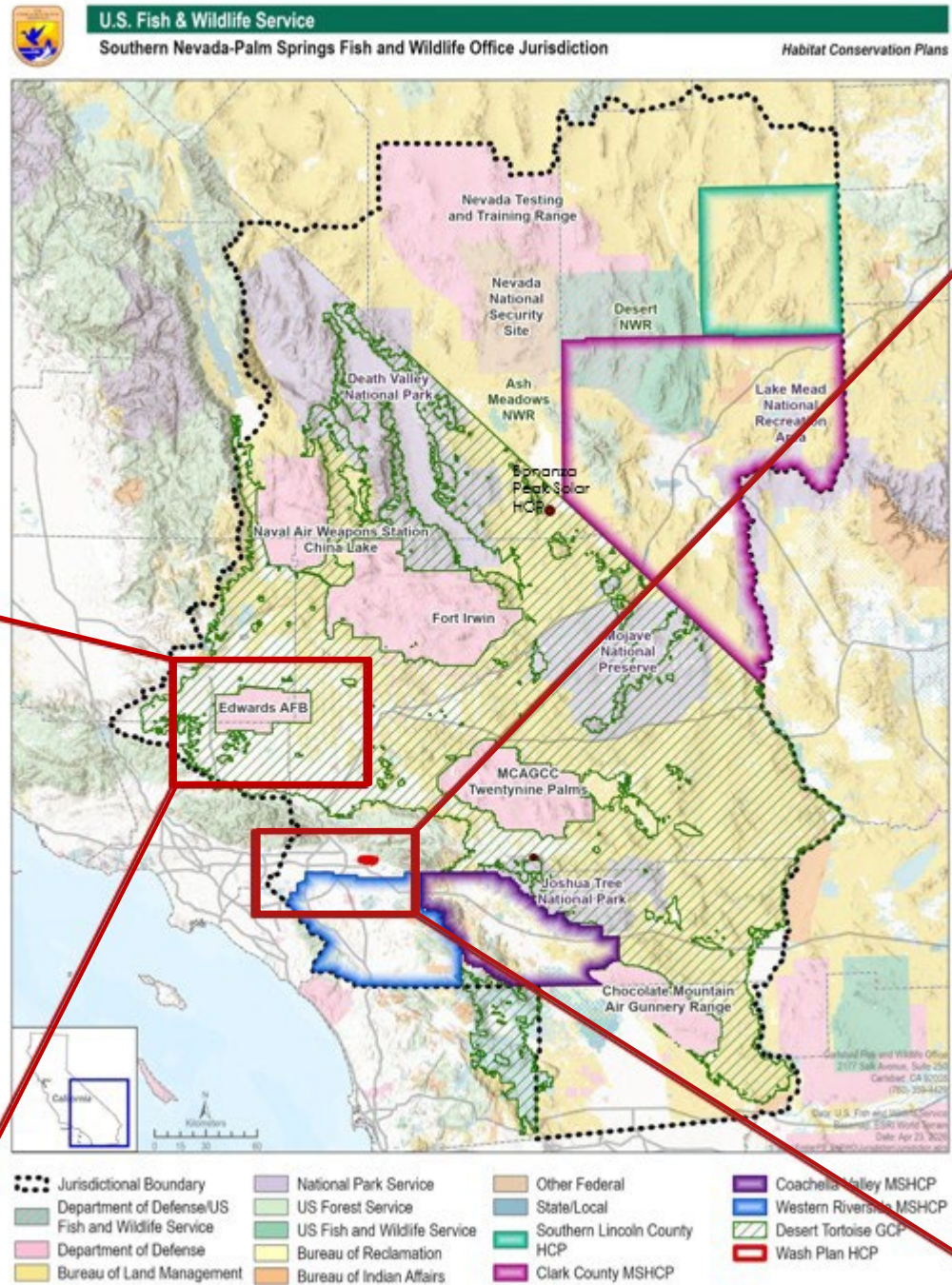
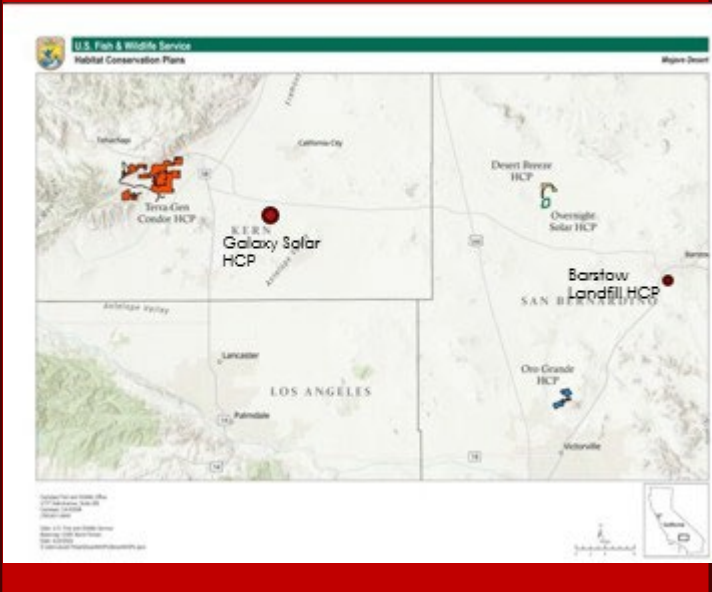


Habitat Conservation Plans in Progress in San Diego, Orange, and Los Angeles Counties. May 2026.

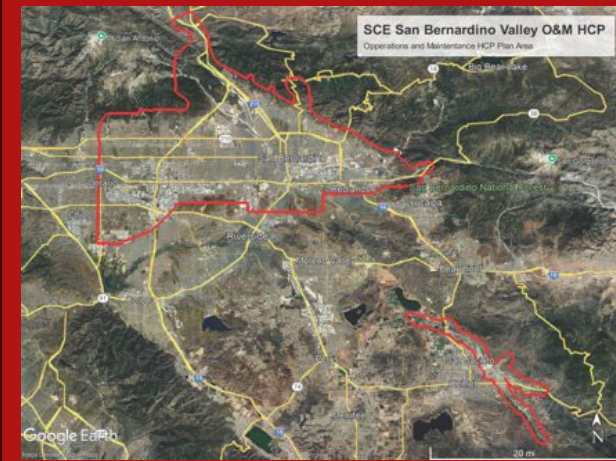
- North SD County MSCP: Covers development activities in most of northern San Diego County and addresses multiple species, not including butterflies. Initial Tribal outreach conducted in coordination with the County, but not NHPA section 106 consultation. Contact is susan_wynn@fws.gov
- SD County Butterfly HCP: Covers development activities throughout unincorporated San Diego County and addresses Quino checkerspot, Laguna Mountains skipper, Hermes copper, and Harbison's dun skipper. No Tribal coordination to date. Contact is eric_porter@fws.gov
- Santee Subarea NCCP/HCP: Covers development activities in the City of Santee and addresses multiple species. Letter requesting NHPA section 106 consultation sent in June 2025. Contact is samantha_padilla@fws.gov
- Sweetwater Authority NCCP/HCP: Covers operation and maintenance within the Sweetwater Authority's jurisdiction from Sweetwater Reservoir down to San Diego Bay. No Tribal coordination to date. Contact is eric_porter@fws.gov
- Quail Meadows HCP: Covers development of an apartment complex in Encinitas and addresses coastal California gnatcatcher. NHPA section 106 consultation complete. Contact is taylor_curtis@fws.gov
- Woodward 46 Specific Plan HCP: Covers residential development in San Marcos and addresses coastal California gnatcatcher. No Tribal coordination to date. Contact is larissa_fields@fws.gov
- Elephant Hill HCP: Covers residential development in Pomona, Los Angeles County, and addresses coastal California gnatcatcher. No Tribal coordination to date. Contact is sandra_hamilton@fws.gov

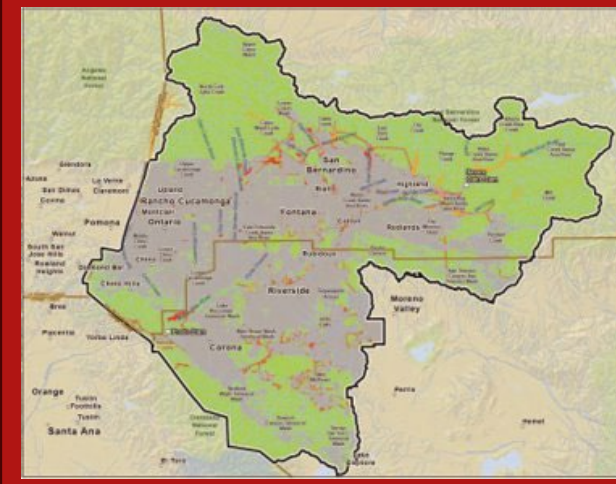

Palm Springs and Southern Nevada Fish and Wildlife Office – Habitat Conservation Plans

- ▶ **Clark County Multiple Species HCP**: covers incidental take permitting for development on non-Federal lands and maintenance of NDOT rights-of-way in Clark County, Nevada until January of 2031. FWS is currently working with Clark County on their next HCP. We expect to send tribal outreach letters for the next HCP in May of 2026.
- ▶ **Desert Tortoise General Conservation Plan**: provides a streamlined mechanism for incidental take permitting for a variety of development activities on non-Federal lands within the California portion of the desert tortoise's range. FWS finalized the NEPA document and signed the GCP in fall of 2025. The GCP is currently available for public use.
- ▶ **Western Riverside Multiple Species HCP**: covers incidental take permitting for a variety of development activities on non-Federal lands in western Riverside County, California. The permittees have begun work on an amendment to the plan to include Crotch's bumblebee and to address other implementation issues.
- ▶ **Southeastern Lincoln County Multiple Species HCP**: covers incidental take permitting for development and ongoing infrastructure maintenance needs on non-Federal lands in Southeastern Lincoln County, Nevada until May of 2040. FWS is currently working with permittees on implementation of the plan.

Palm Springs and Southern Nevada Fish and Wildlife Office – Habitat Conservation Plans continued

- ▶ **Barstow Landfill HCP**: would provide incidental take coverage for the desert tortoise for a expansion of the existing Barstow Municipal landfill in San Bernardino County, California. The draft HCP is in progress and will be released for public comment in summer/fall 2026. We plan to conduct Tribal outreach in summer 2026.
- ▶ **Bonanza Peak Solar**: would provide incidental take coverage for the desert tortoise during construction, operations and maintenance, and decommissioning of a solar project on 3,382 acres in Inyo County, California. The draft HCP is in progress and pending Departmental review could be released for public comment as soon as summer/fall 2026. We plan to conduct Tribal outreach in summer 2026.
- ▶ **Galaxy Solar HCP**: would provide incidental take coverage for the desert tortoise during construction, operations and maintenance, and decommissioning of a 3,400 acre solar project in Kern County, California. The draft HCP is in progress and pending Departmental review could be released for public comment as soon as summer/fall 2026. We plan to conduct Tribal outreach in summer 2026..
- ▶ **Geneva Solar HCP**: would provide incidental take coverage for the desert tortoise during construction, operations and maintenance, and decommissioning of a 184 acre solar project in San Bernardino County, California. The draft HCP is in progress and pending Departmental review could be released for public comment as soon as summer/fall 2026. We plan to conduct Tribal outreach in summer 2026.
- ▶ **Oro Grande Cement Mine HCP**: would provide incidental take coverage for the desert tortoise on a 285-acre mine expansion in San Bernardino County, California. The draft HCP is complete and will be released for public comment in May 2026. We conducted Tribal outreach and discussed this project with the Yuhaaviatam of San Manuel Nation.
- ▶ **Terra Gen Wind Energy HCP**: would provide incidental take coverage for the California condor on 14 existing projects across 11,378 acres in the Tehachapi Wind Resource Area in Kern County, California. The draft HCP and NEPA documents are complete and pending Departmental review will be released for public comment as soon as summer 2026. We sent Tribal outreach letters on this project in May of 2025.

Palm Springs and Southern Nevada Fish and Wildlife Office – Habitat Conservation Plans continued

- ▶ **Upper Santa Ana River Multiple Species HCP**: would provide incidental take coverage for multiple species potentially affected by water delivery and operations and maintenance activities in southern California's Upper Santa Ana River Watershed. Draft HCP is in final internal review and will be released for public comment in 2026. We plan to send out tribal outreach letters for this HCP in June or July, 2026.
- ▶ **SCE Operations and Maintenance Multiple Species HCP**: would provide incidental take coverage for multiple species potentially affected by operations and maintenance of SCEs existing facilities in San Bernardino Valley, California. Draft HCP under development. SCE has paused work on the San Bernadino Valley HCP and is considering addressing their facilities state-wide. We will undertake tribal outreach after we receive a revised draft of the HCP.
