Applicants will apply for a hunt date at a first come first served basis, with a max hunt group of three on our Recreation.gov website at: <https://www.recreation.gov/permits/5262626>. Hunters will only be able to purchase one group permit at a time, with a one time reservation fee of \$6.00 and each hunter recreation fee of \$9.00 each. All hunters MUST submit a hunters permit to the hunt coordinator at alyssa_lu@fws.gov by two weeks before their hunt date or they are subject to cancellation of their hunts. Please be sure to read all sections on the website before purchasing hunt permits. No refunds will be issued at anytime. Each hunter is only allowed to purchase up to two hunt dates per hunt group regardless of association. If there is a violation of this rule, violators will be subject to immediate cancellation with no refund for additional purchases and may be barred from any future hunts on refuge. Up to three hunters may apply and hunt together from the same blind.

Hunt dates will open for purchase September 2, 2026, on a first come, first served basis.

PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT

Authority: The information requested is authorized by the National Wildlife Refuge System Administration Act (16 U.S.C. 668dd-ee) as amended and the Refuge Recreation Act (16 U.S.C. 460k – 460k-4, 640K-3, & 664).

Purpose: The collection of personal information is to verify that an individual is eligible to receive a permit to conduct monitored activity on areas within the National Wildlife Refuge System, national fish hatcheries, and other conservation areas administered by the Secretary of the Interior for fish and wildlife purposes.

PAPERWORK REDUCTION ACT STATEMENT
