

RECOGNIZED QUALIFIED DWARF WEDGEMUSSEL SURVEYORS

The following list includes individuals recognized by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (Service), New Jersey Field Office, and the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP), Endangered and Nongame Species Program as qualified to conduct surveys for the federally endangered dwarf wedgemussel (*Alasmodonta heterodon*). This list may not include all individuals qualified to survey for this species. This list will be updated periodically. Inclusion of names on this list does not constitute endorsement by the Service or any other U.S. Government agency or State agency.

To conduct surveys for dwarf wedgemussels in New Jersey, a scientific collecting permit from the NJDEP is also required.

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
