Status of the Species and Critical Habitat

The Status of the Species and Critical Habitat accounts in this appendix are in draft form. The information currently in the accounts was collected by consultants and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service staff between 2014 and 2017 and updated in 2019, for use in the national pesticide consultations, though they were created in a manner to be used for any consultation. All listed, proposed and candidate species and their critical habitats through November 2019, should have a draft Status of the Species and Critical Habitat account. The accounts represent point-in-time information, predominantly from publicly available data, and typically from U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service listing decisions, recovery plans, 5-year reviews, species status assessments, etc. However, they have yet to be reviewed and finalized by U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service species experts. As a result, they may not necessarily encompass all the information that is available or known by species leads or the most recent knowledge regarding the species.
