

Volunteer Opportunity

The U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service is seeking a volunteer to assist with Refuge maintenance and habitat restoration efforts at Bandon Marsh National Wildlife Refuge.

Volunteer would assist with year-round maintenance and grounds keeping of refuge facilities and trails. Additional tasks include invasive species removal and habitat restoration. This position is vital to maintaining public use spaces and native habitat on the Refuge.



Requirements:

- Ability to work outside on uneven terrain and in temperatures ranging 45-70 degrees Fahrenheit.
- Ability to do strenuous and physically demanding tasks.
- Comfortable properly using a weed whip, lawn mower, and other equipment.
- Commitment to regular volunteer schedule of three - four hours, two - four times a month.
