What are the performance measures (aka, evaluation criteria and response variables)?	<p>Performance Measures (using resilience, redundancy, and representativeness see CoT report):</p> <p>Resilience - 1) At the population level, abundance or proxy, e.g., patch occupancy, or derived measures, e.g., popn growth or trend. 2) At the PAC (cf COT Report), amount, extent, and quality of sagebrush shrub and native perennial grass and forb communities.</p> <p>Redundancy - At the level of "geographic area of interest" and Management Zone, derived from population level measures, 1) number or percent of populations that persist and 2) well distributed and connected healthy sagebrush shrub and native perennial grass and forb communities.</p> <p>Representativeness - Qualitative or categorical measure of loss of adaptive capacity through loss of genetic diversity or geographic diversity (e.g., loss of genetic clusters as defined by Oyler-McCance et al. and loss of populations at margins of range).</p>	<p>ACTION ITEM:</p> <p>Review - Inclusion of Habitat Threats and Threat abatement as means performance measures</p>
